

MOTHER'S DAY GATHERING, PARLIAMENT HILL, NOON, SUNDAY MAY 12 - LET'S COME TOGETHER IN A SHOW OF PEACE AND SUPPORT FOR DETECTIVE GRUS' INVESTIGATION INTO AN OTTAWA CLUSTER OF SUDDEN INFANT DEATH

Who: Detective Helen Grus, Ottawa Police Service's Sexual Assault and Child Abuse (SACA) unit, charged July 2022 with 'discreditable conduct' for her investigation into an Ottawa cluster of seven sudden deaths of breastfeeding babies seeking to know the mother's Covid vaccination status.

Two of the seven SIDS babies actually died in their mother's arms.

"These two cases struck a bell suddenly that day because both those babies were sent home healthy. Both those mothers picked them up to feed them, and both of those babies collapsed and went limp in the mother's arms. It still gives me chills ... I'm a police officer; I'm there to solve and help solve if somebody dies. Especially an innocent little baby ... I don't want more babies to die. Whether it's vaccine-related or not ... I'm not okay with babies dying and not getting any answers." Detective Grus' statement, August 14, 2023 hearing.



Why: *"The eternal Golden Rule of Pregnancy for millennia has been you never ever introduce a novel substance in pregnancy."* Obstetrician/gynecologist and maternal fetal medicine physician Dr. James Thorp. Yet, Detective Grus has not been allowed to ask if the mothers of these precious babies received the novel Covid shot. Yet, Dr. James Thorp and Detective Grus' four other expert witnesses have not been allowed to testify in her hearings? WHY?

What: A Mother's Day gathering in the founding spirit and purpose of Mother's Day as proclaimed by Julia Ward Howe 154 years ago: *"APPEAL TO WOMANHOOD THROUGHOUT THE WORLD ... Arise, all women who have hearts whether your baptism be that of water or of tears! Let them meet first, as women, to bewail and commemorate the dead. Let them then solemnly take council with each other as to the means whereby the great human family can live in peace ... Helen Grus' case is scheduled to resume, May 27, 2024, two weeks after Mother's Day, which happens to be Julia Ward Howe's 205th birthday. Why did these apparently healthy babies suddenly die? Is there a potential connection between the vaccination status of the mothers and the sudden deaths of breastfeeding babies?

MOTHER'S DAY PROCLAMATION ~ JULIA WARD HOWE 1870

Also known as the Appeal to Womanhood Throughout the World

Again, in the sight of the Christian world, have the skill and power of two great nations exhausted themselves in mutual murder. Again have the sacred questions of international justice been committed to the fatal mediation of military weapons. In this day of progress, in this century of light, the ambition of rulers has been allowed to barter the dear interests of domestic life for the bloody exchanges of the battle field. Thus men have done. Thus men will do. But women need no longer be made a party to proceedings which fill the globe with grief and horror. Despite the assumptions of physical force, the mother has a sacred and commanding word to say to the sons who owe their life to her suffering. That word should now be heard, and answered to as never before.

Arise, then, Christian women of this day! Arise, all women who have hearts whether your baptism be that of water or of tears! Say firmly: We will not have great questions decided by irrelevant agencies. Our husbands shall not come to us, reeking with carnage, for carresses and applause. Our sons shall not be taken from us to unlearn all that we have been able to teach them of charity, mercy and patience. We, women of one country, will be too tender of those of another country, to allow our sons to be trained to injure theirs. From the bosom of the devastated earth a voice goes up with our own. It says: Disarm, disarm! The sword of murder is not the balance of justice. Blood does not wipe out dishonor, nor violence vindicate possession. As men have often forsaken the plough and the anvil at the summons of war, let women now leave all that may be left of home for a great and earnest day of council.

Let them meet first, as women, to bewail and commemorate the dead. Let them then solemnly take council with each other as to the means whereby the great human family can live in peace, man as the brother of man, each bearing after his own kind the sacred impress, not of Cæsar, but of God.

In the name of womanhood and of humanity, I earnestly ask that a general congress of women, without limit of nationality, may be appointed and held at some place deemed most convenient, and at the earliest period consistent with its objects, to promote the alliance of the different nationalities, the amicable settlement of international questions, the great and general interests of peace.
